 I authorize LUCY'S DOGGY DAY CARE AND SPA to allow my dog(s) to engage in social play with other dogs. In doing so, I understand my dog(s) may become injured by interacting with other dogs. I also understand that LUCY'S DOGGY DAY CARE AND SPA has evaluated the personalities of all dogs engaged in play will supervise the playtimes, and will use reasonable care to ensure that no injuries result. However, in the event that an injury does occur to my dog(s) during group play, I agree to hold LUCY'S DOGGY DAY CARE AND SPA harmless from damages resulting from such injury. I agree to pay all veterinary charges required to properly treat my dog(s) for such injury. I understand that due to the excessive running and playing outdoors, my dog's paws/pads may be sensitive & tender as a result from worn pads. Initial: All dogs are boarded, trained or otherwise cared for by LUCY'S DOGGY DAY CARE AND SPA, without liability on its part for loss or damage by or from disease, death, running away, theft, fire or injury to persons, other dogs, or property by or to said dog(s), or other unavoidable causes, due diligence and care having been exercised. • I understand that all dogs at LUCY'S DOGGY DAY CARE AND SPA are vaccinated and healthy, but that there are viruses (e.g., colds, Bordetella, Conjunctivitis, Giardia and Papilloma Virus) that cannot be fully vaccinated against and that in a social setting such as day care, my dog may be exposed to such.  Daycare/boarding charges are still applicable even if the dog(s) are not participating in interactive daycare to include: dogs that have been pulled for diarrhea, vomiting, sore pads, "behavior time outs" or any other reason, for the session or for 24 hours. Initial:
damages, debts, resulting from such medical care, including but not limited to, transportation to/from the veterinarian clinic and choice of veterinarian or animal hospital. Initial: LUCY'S DOGGY DAY CARE AND SPA does not permit into Interactive Daycare any dog whose breed is Pit Bull, American Staffordshire Terrier, Staffordshire
Bull Terrier, American Pit Bull Terrier, American Bull Dog, Shar Pei, Dogo Argentino, Presa Canario, Fila Brasileiro as well as dogs mixed with these breeds. Wolves or Wolf hybrids are not permitted for any services. I authorize LUCYS DOGGY DAYCARE AND SPA to transport my dog(s) in a motor vehicle for purposes such as veterinary visits or for any other such reason
if necessary. I understand and agree to the risks associated therewith. Initial: To qualify for interactive daycare, eligible dogs are required to be spayed or neutered and temperament tested. (Pups younger than 8-months-old needn't be spayed or neutered.) Dogs not eligible for interactive daycare may still board and will have a minimum of four and up to six 5/10-minute leash free spacious back yard rotations. Initial:
 Due to the fragile nature of pups under 6 pounds and the elevated risk of injury due to rough play, pups under 6 pounds may not be eligible for interactive play. The determination will be made at store level and may fluctuate depending on the dynamics of the playgroup. Initial: Pups 9 years or older may be placed on our limited playtime (traditional limited play hours are 7:30am-10am and 3:30pm-5pm). The determination will be

 I represent that I am the legal owner of said dog(s) Initial: Pups that are left in our care over 30 days with no payment are subject to owner surrender. Initial:
ADDITIONAL HEALTH POLICIES
• Any dogs showing signs of extreme lethargy or signs of heat stress will be taken to the veterinarian immediately even if we are unable to contact you first. Initial:
• Dogs that are heartworm positive or undergoing heartworm treatment are not permitted for any services. Once the treatment for heartworms is complete, veterinary recommendation is to wait 6 months before testing for heartworms to avoid a false positive. Once your pup is heartworm negative, they are permitted to use services at Lucy's.
 Dogs susceptible to over-heating, geriatric, have a heart murmur, Cushing's or other medical conditions may be placed on a limited playtime.
• Non-spayed females that are in heat or pregnant females are not permitted for any services. If your pup goes into heat during their boarding stay, she will need to be picked up by an alternate party or transferred to a vet. Females who have had an ovarian sparing spay are not eligible for interactive
daycare. • For the safety of your dogs, non-spayed females and non-neutered males, over the age of 8 months cannot board together and will receive separate individual potty rotations. Initial:
In the event your dog(s) need to be taken to the veterinarian for non-emergency purposes, there is a \$20.00 fee associated per dog. Initial:

 Lucy's is a flea-free environment. If a dog has fleas/ticks, the dog will be given a Capstar and bathed at the owner's expense. Initial:
 During interactive outdoor play, my dog may be exposed to insects such as ants, bee's, or wasp's. I give Lucy's Doggy Daycare & Spa consent to take m'dog to a veterinarian to treat my dog(s) at the owner's expense if my dog(s) ingest or get stung by said insect. Initial:
VACCINATION POLICIES
 We require documentation of Rabies and Distemper /Parvovirus every year or 3 years (depending on the vaccines your veterinarian administers), Bordetella annually and we highly recommend the bivalent canine influenza vaccine (H3N26H3N8) annually. Any expired vaccination must be administered 5 days in advance of boarding/daycare or grooming. Lucy's does not accept home administered vaccines, hand written vaccines, sticker/checkmark booklets and require all vaccinations to be administered by a licensed veterinarian listed on a printed invoice. BOARDING/HOLIDAY POLICIES
• A boarding charge applies when a dog stays overnight at LUCY'S DOGGY DAY CARE AND SPA. Although a dog may not stay the second night, a day care fer will be added if the dog is not picked up within a 28hr period of the initial drop off. Late fees will apply if pet is picked up after closing hours: \$1.00 per minute will be billed. Initial:
• There is a \$5 per day charge when feeding your dog with "house" food (House food is Purina Veterinary Diet EN). Initial:
• We cannot guarantee that toys and orthopedic beds will be kept in the same condition as brought in. For safety reasons, tennis balls and rawhide are NO permitted. Initial:
• LUCY'S DOGGY DAYCARE & SPA requires a credit card saved on file for all boarding reservations at the time the reservation is made. Payment for half of your pups boarding stay is required at the time of drop off if staying seven or more nights. Reservations extended past 7 nights; half of the anticipated stay will be charged. Initial:
 During holiday time periods we require notification of cancellation 48 hours prior to your reservation. One night's stay will be charged if notification is not received within this time frame. Initial:
 There is a \$5 holiday surcharge per dog, per night, for the following dates: the day before Memorial Day, Memorial Day, July 3rd/4th, the day before Labor Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Eve, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve, Christmas Day, New Year's Eve and Day. The quantity stay discount is <u>not valid</u> during holidays (We do not offer daycare services the day after a holiday for dogs that are not eligible for "interactive" daycare.) For the safety of your dog(s), Lucy's Doggy Daycare & Spa only allows dogs who live in the same household to board together. All pups need to be able to be handled and cared for by our staff. In the event your pup is not able to be handled, or is showing signs of aggression, he/shows the same household to be able to be handled.
will need to be picked up immediately. Initial: Please bring medications in a container (preferably in the original bottle). There is no charge for administering medication.
• In the event that my pet is matted, I understand there may be an additional de-matting charge. There may be a wiggle-worm fee for dogs that require additional handling. For the safety and comfort of your dog, Lucy's reserves the right to refuse service if your dog has extreme matting or is extremely hard to handle. Initial:
• If your pet is excessively matted a Smoothie/Shave Down fee starting at \$10 will be applied. Excessive matting may cause skin irritation, hematomas of
discomfort due to limited blood flow as a result of the matting. Initial: In an effort to provide great service for all of our grooming clients, any no shows or appointments cancelled without at least 24 hours' notice will be
charged a \$20.00 cancellation fee. If you are late for your appointment, your appointment is subject to be rescheduled. Initial: • If a pup is dropped off 30 minutes prior to your appointment time, or picked up 1 hour after the notification call that your pup is ready, a half-day daycare fee of \$25.00 will be applied, and your pup(s) will be placed on the daycare potty rotation. BORDETELLA (Kennel Cough) Agreement

LUCY'S DOGGY DAY CARE AND SPA follows the American Boarding Kennels Association recommendation requiring the Bordetella (Kennel Cough) vaccination annually. However, vaccinated canines are still susceptible to various strains of the virus. The vaccines for Bordetella only cover a few strains of the virus.

I understand that although my dog is vaccinated against Bordetella, it is not a guarantee that my dog will not contract some form of the virus. I also understand that although rare, Kennel Cough can evolve into more serious respiratory infections that may become critical, i.e. bronchopneumonia or chronic bronchitis. It is a heightened risk for puppies, senior dogs or immunocompromised dogs. I understand these risks and will not hold LUCY's DOGGY DAYCARE AND SPA liable or responsible for any veterinary expenses.
